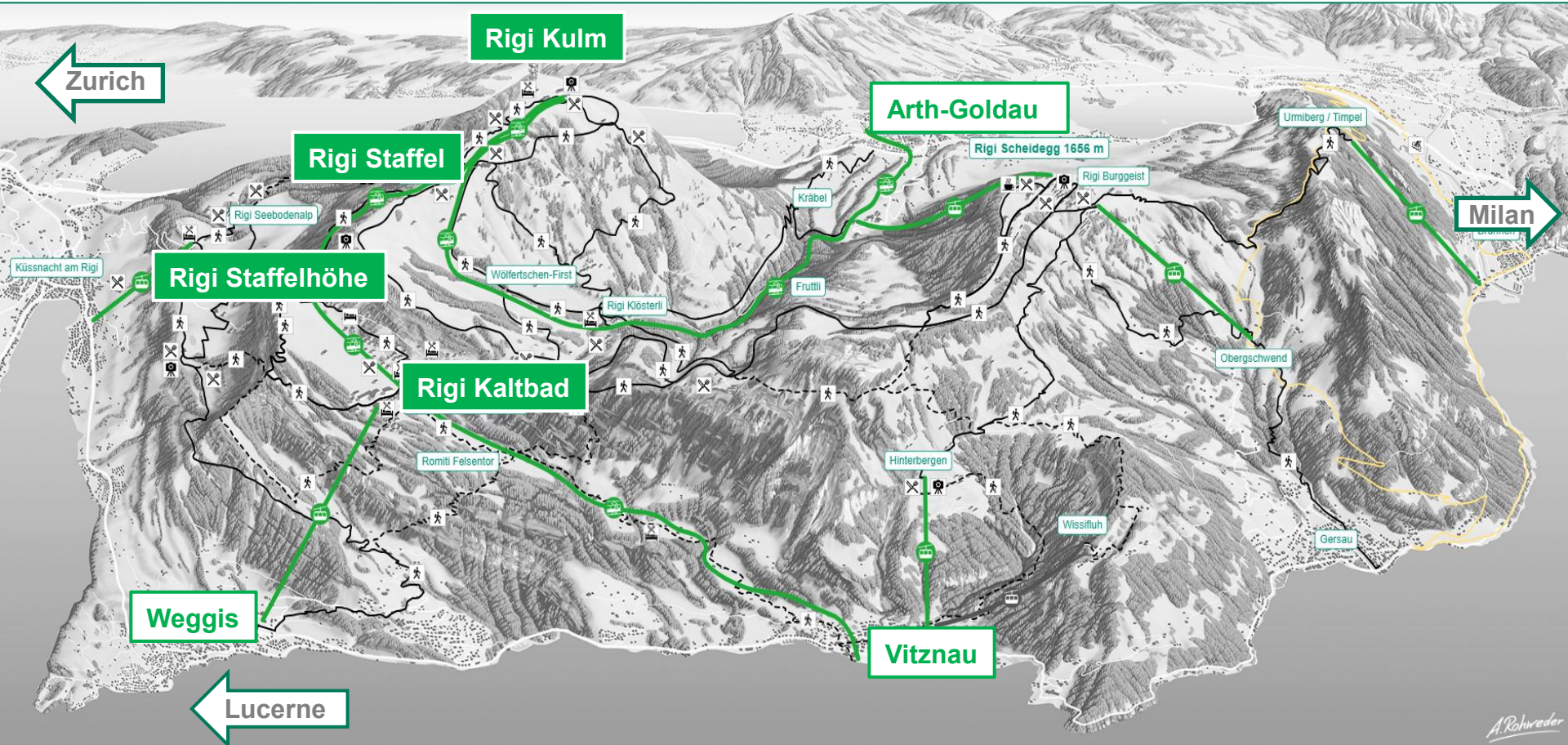

Reservation handling

Groups (10 and more paying adults):

- Reservation is mandatory for a group of 10 persons and more, please let the reservations team the origin of your travelling guests know
- If a group reservation drops to less than 10 paying adults, it will then be charged at FIT rates without separate notice
- No reservation fee applies, seat reservation in trains is included in the group rate

FIT (1-9 paying adults):

Either you directly book in the reseller-shop or you send your booking request to the Guest Service Team

There will be aperitif rides and steam trains will steam up to the Queen of the Mountains. Request the dates (welcome@rigi.ch), book a seat on one of the special trains and enjoy royal moments on Rigi mountain.

Travel in glamour

The unique and luxurious carriages – the “Belle Époque” (from/to Vitznau, 2 x 36 seats) dating from 1873, “Carriage No. 6” (from/to Arth-Goldau, 1 x 50 seats) from 1911, and “Carriage No. 35” (from/to Arth-Goldau, 1 x 35 seats) from 1899 – are true jewels that have hosted numerous distinguished guests and celebrities since the 19th century. The charter rate is CHF 2,000 (up to 15 guests; from 16 guests onwards: additional CHF 60 per person). Included are a train day ticket, guide, snacks & drinks on the way up, and a scheduled train ride down.

Easy accessible in 20 minutes from Rigi Kaltbad you find the Alp First, which is a newly built cheese dairy on Mt. Rigi. Its production focuses on regional high quality products. Since the opening in early summer 2025, Alp First became a favourite experience among locals as well as visitors.

Group offers (min. 10 persons):

- Guided Tour with degustation: CHF 90 / per additional person CHF 9.00
- Guided Tour with aperitif: CHF 130 / per additional person CHF 13.00

Description of services:

- Guided Tour:
Joint tour of the production facilities including explanations and a Q&A session (approx. 45–60 minutes)

A small tasting of all cheeses currently available for sale

The guide will then prepare an authentic BBQ the very simple Swiss style. If the customers are willing to assist, they are more than welcome. Enjoy!

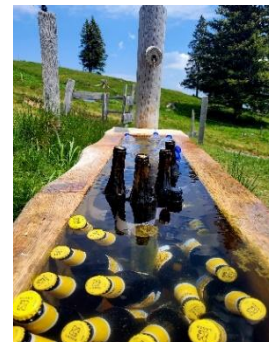

Just a few meters from the train tracks where you get off at Rigi Kulm, a new indoor attraction opened its doors in spring 2026. Ambient lighting, historical videos, and original audio recordings bring the heart of the steam era to life.

Discover how Locomotive No. 7 once conquered the “Queen of the Mountains,” and immerse yourself in the pioneering days of **Europe’s first mountain railway**:

1873 the locomotive was built in Winterthur and belonged to the first generation of Rigi Railways rolling stock.

1959 the locomotive found its place in the Swiss Museum of Transport’s National Mobility Collection in Lucerne.

2020 the locomotive was spectacularly transported by water from Lucerne to Vitznau and remained on Mt. Rigi to the present day.

2021 it was back on track for the 150-year anniversary after being restored by our dedicated staff and is since then regularly steaming up the mountain.

2026 the Lok 7 gets its own exhibition on Mt. Rigi, while still in use on specific dates during summer.
